

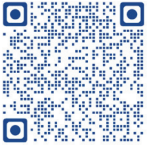

THE RULES OF THE ROYAL & ANCIENT AND USGA GOVERN ALL PLAY

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS

Is marked by white posts and the fence surrounding the course.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

G.U.R. is marked by blue posts. Staked trees are G.U.R. In cases of interference (Rule 16-1a) the player must take relief under Rule 16-1b.

ROADS AND PATHS

If a ball lies on the paved part of a road or path, the player may take relief under Rule 16-1.

BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Matchplay: loss of hole Strokeplay: 2 penalty strokes

POWER LINES

If a ball strikes a power line, the player must disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play a ball as near as possible to the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance

with Rule 14-6.

TREE BASINS

Tree basins are an integral part of the golf course. The player must play the ball as it lies or play the ball according to Rule 28.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a.
